TO: All Instructors, Tennessee

A 2010 incentive program is being kicked no earlier than December 1, 2009 for Tennessee DSP instructors. Each Zone/District Coordinator will designate a 12 month period in their Zone/District (needs to be the same for everyone in that Zone or District) for this incentive.


Each instructor who has 100 or more course participants during the 12 month period, according to Course Tuition & Expense Reports (CTER) submitted, will received a men's or women's watch, as appropriate, which is inscribed with AARP Driver Safety Program, Century Club. Currently the Zone/District Coordinators, Trainers, Marketing Specialist, and Telephone Coordinators each have a sample of this watch (without the "Century Club" nomenclature. So, you can see a sample of the watch from your coordinator.

Also, those who team teach, where only one instructor submits the CTER, should make a note on the pink copy of their CTER of the name of the instructor who co-taught the course with them before sending it to their supervisor. Also include a separate note to that effect so that the coordinator is clearly aware. Only one additional instructor may co-teach a course and must be present for the entire course (all eight units).

Coordinators are to keep track of the number of participants for each instructor during their designated 12 month period.

Watches will be presented when an instructor achieves the Century Club status for 2010 or at such time as the District/Zone Coordinator chooses after that accomplishment (such as a District/Zone meeting, etc.).
