AARP DRIVER SAFETY PROGRAM courses are presented to improve the safety of the mature driver (50 and older). Tennessee law provides a discount on auto insurance costs for graduates of the 8-hour course who are 55 and older if they have had a good driving record for three years. No driving; no written test to pass; only participation in classroom discussion. The course costs \$12 or \$14, which is payable to AARP DSP for course materials. Instructors are volunteers.
